

# Exciting New Opportunity!!!!!!

New this for year's Youth Project Show is the opportunity for an Overall Grand and Reserve Project to be chosen and sold in the GCF&R Jr. Auction on Wednesday night.

1. You must designate on the entry form if you desire your project to be considered in the judging for overall grand or reserve project.
2. If your project is chosen as overall Grand or Reserve you **MUST** sell your project in the auction on Wednesday night.
3. Perishable items such as baked goods and cake decorating will not be eligible for the overall grand and reserve.
4. All Best of Show items except perishables and those designated as a no sale by the exhibitor on the entry forms will be considered for the overall Grand and Reserve Project.
5. **The Overall Grand & Reserve Winners will have photos of their project taken to be displayed on the screen at the auction. The Exhibitor will go across the auction block at their designated lot # and the photo of their project will be displayed on the screen at that time. This year the Auction will be live and streamed online with Cattle In Motion at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 21, 2021.**
6. Exhibitors chosen as overall Grand and Reserve will pick up their projects on Sunday, April 18, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p. m. You will need to be present at the Junior Auction on Wednesday, April 21 at 6:00 p.m. You will need to pick up your copy of the auction sale sheet on April 24<sup>th</sup> from 12 noon to 6:00 p.m. in the Livestock Office or you can pick up your sale sheet at the Fair Office starting on Monday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. You need this sale sheet so you can make arrangements with your buyer to get your project to them.
7. A Proof of Delivery Form and thank you card (see General Rule #44) will be required before Exhibitor's check can be released. All exhibitors must come to the Fair Office, with these items, to sign for their check.
8. Fair officials reserve the right to change the rules, dates, times and places due to unforeseen circumstances.
9. Any questions should be directed to the chairman or co-chairman of the committee.
