I. ENTRIES

All Entries must be an **ILLUSTRATION**.

Exhibitors Choice of:

- a. Category I: Medium: Ink, pencil, pen & ink & charcoal (**BLACK & WHITE**).
Category II: Medium: Oil, acrylic, pastels, map colors, crayons, water colors & markers (**MULTI-COLOR**).
- b. Size: with a maximum size of 24" X 30" overall size, including matte.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

- a. Students from kindergarten through 12th grade may enter, but must be enrolled in the Galveston County School District. **Limit two entries per student. NOTE: Each exhibitor will receive one "one day pass" for free admission into the Fairgrounds.**
- b. All Student Art Show participants will be subject to Texas House Rule 72. (No Pass, No Play). A Declaration of Eligibility Form will be sent to the exhibitor's school for verification of eligibility. Eligibility Forms will be handled by the Fair Office.
- c. Artwork is due between **3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Friday, April 16, 2021**, in the Ed Pickett Memorial Hall on the Fairgrounds.
- d. Blue, Red and White place ribbons will be awarded in each of the four (4) grade levels. Grade levels will be K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12. Best of Show and Honorable Mention Rosettes will be awarded. These will be picked from Blue Ribbon entries.
- e. All entries for the Art Show must be illustrations that have not been previously exhibited at the Galveston County Fair.
- f. Artwork will be displayed in a sectioned area to help protect them; however, the **GCF&R is not responsible for any damage to your artwork.**
- g. **Illustrations must be matted with 4-ply black matt board only, 1/4" foam board on back of non-canvas paintings. Matt to (11x14), (16x20), or (24x30) picture will be smaller than matt. Double matting is ok so long as both matts are black. No wooden, metal, resin or any kind of framed artwork will be accepted. All artwork must be sealed with shrink-wrap or clear plastic to protect the artwork, (it is not necessary to shrink-wrap Oil or Acrylic Paintings) BEFORE your art work will be allowed to enter the building. (Shrink-wrap is available at Hobby Lobby)**
- h. No commercial objects or lettering may be used as part of any entry. No glitter may be used on any part of any entry.
- i. **Each entry should be the exhibitor's original idea and work. Once the artwork is checked in, you will not be allowed to change anything on your artwork.**
- j. The following information must be typed or legibly printed on a 3" X 5" index card: **Title of picture, type of entry, i.e., pencil, oil, ink, map colors, pastels, pen & ink, crayon watercolor, markers etc., exhibitor's name, address, phone number, age, school district, and teacher.** The card must be attached to the back of artwork in the lower right hand corner. If the cards cannot be read the entry will be disqualified. SEE ATTACHED.
- k. Each participant is required to sign an Indemnity Form attached to the Entry Form. Failure to complete the form will result in disqualification.

III. JUDGING

- a. Judging will be at **7:00 p.m. on Friday, April 16, and Saturday, April 17 at 9 a.m.**
- b. No exhibitors, parents, or teachers will be allowed in judging area until Sunday, April 16, 2021 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. for Check out.
- c. **Judging criteria:**

Neatness	40 points
Originality	10 points
Composition	25 points
Use of Medium	25 points

IV. **AWARDS**

- a. There will be two (2) separate categories:
 - Category I: Ink, pencil, pen & ink & charcoal **(BLACK & WHITE)**
 - Category II: Oil, acrylic, pastels, map color, crayon, watercolors & markers **(MULTI-COLOR)**

There could possible be a total of sixteen (16) winners, two (2) in each grade level, in each category.
- b. Blue, Red, and White Ribbons will be awarded, according to the score given to the entry by the judges. The scores will be as follows:
 - BLUE RIBBON: 100-90
 - RED RIBBON: 89-80
 - WHITE RIBBON: 79-and below.
- c. The Best of Show and Honorable Mention rosette items must be Blue Ribbon Awards.
- d. Checks will be mailed out within 60 days from the end of the Fair.
