\$25.00 due with entry if received after February 21, 2019 – SORRY, NO REFUNDS! All entries must be received in the Fair Office by 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, March 7, 2019. No entries will be accepted after this date.

JUDGING: Interviews will be held on Sunday, March 24, 2019 beginning at 2:00 p.m. in the Youth Building
Contest will be held on Saturday, April 6, 2019 at approximately 11:00 a.m. at the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo Entertainment Pavilion

Sponsors for the event are needed. Sponsors will be recognized in the program and during the event. Those interested in helping sponsor the event with a cash donation to be used for trophies or gifts for the winners should check the box on the attached entry form.

Trophies are not awarded to all contestants, please see rule # 10. If you are interested in purchasing a trophy to give to your child, the cost is \$8.00. This fee must be paid in advance and must be received by February 21, 2019.

1. Tiny Mister and Tiny Miss contestants must be ages 3 – 5 as of the date of the contest. Lil' Mister and Lil' Miss contestants must be ages 6 years – 2nd grade as of the date of the contest.
2. Contestants will be required to submit an Emergency Medical and Indemnity Form with their entry form. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of the contestant.
3. A recent photograph of the contestant must be submitted with the entry form. **This photograph will be published in promotional materials for the Fair. (NO GLAMOUR SHOTS ACCEPTED.) Entry must be submitted by February 21, 2019 to be published in the promotional materials.**
4. Tiny and Lil' contestants may ride in the Parade which will be held on Saturday, March 23, 2019. Contestants will assemble at 9:00 a.m. at the VFW Post 5400 Parking Lot, Hwy 6 in Santa Fe and the parade will start at 10:00 a.m. All contestants will ride on one float. Western Wear will be the attire for the parade. The theme of the parade will be "Party 'Till The Cows Come Home".
5. The contestant's parent(s) or guardian(s) agree with the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. that the contest is for the purpose of extending an opportunity for the contestants to participate in a good experience and fun event. Each contestant is expected to act properly and to present a good image.
6. Arrangements may be made for the winning Tiny Mister and Tiny Miss and Lil' Mister and Lil' Miss contestants to ride in future parades.
7. The interviews will be held on March 24, 2019. Tiny and Lil' contestants will be judged at the interview on personality, attire and poise. The contest judging will be held on April 6, 2019. Contestants will be judged on the day of the contest on talent.
8. At the interview, Tiny and Lil' contestants will be asked a series of simple questions in front of the judges. During the contest, they will be introduced on stage and then have the opportunity to perform a simple talent (maximum time limit of three minutes) such as singing, telling jokes, skipping rope, or whatever talent they have that they do best.
9. Contestants' parent(s) or guardian(s) agree the time, manner, and method of judging shall be within the discretion of the Galveston County Fair & Rodeo, Inc. and the decision of the judges in final. If you would like a copy of your score sheet (s) mailed to you, please turn in a self-addressed stamped envelope the day of the Contest and they will be mailed to you the following week.
10. Only the contestants are allowed free admission the day of the Contest.
11. **One boy will be named Tiny Mister Cowboy and one girl will be named Tiny Miss Cowgirl. One boy will be named Lil' Mister Cowboy and one girl will be named Lil' Miss Cowgirl. There will also be awards for 1st and 2nd runner up in each category, a Congeniality Award, Best Dressed Overall and Most Talented Overall. EACH CONTESTANT WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO WIN IN ONE CATEGORY.**
12. A **parent and contestant** meeting will be held **Thursday, March 7, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. in the Youth Building** located at the Galveston County Fairgrounds. A parent should try to attend the meeting to sign up for interview times.
