Terms and Conditions

Exhibitor Covenants

- a) For purposes of this agreement, Galveston county Fair & Rodeo, Inc., Galveston County Fair & Rodeo Management and Directors shall be referred to as GCF&R.
- b) Exhibitor agrees to abide by all rules and regulations adopted by GCF&R and contained in this agreement.
- c) Exhibitor agrees to obtain liability insurance from GCF&R or submit proof of liability insurance listing GCF&R as a certificate holder.
- d) All matters not covered in these rules and regulations are subject to the decision of GCF&R. Participants agree that all disputes will be subject to the final decision of GCF&R.
- e) It is the exhibitors' duty to be familiar with all rules, requirements and regulations contained herein.
- f) In the event Exhibitor defaults in the performance of any of the terms and regulations contained in this agreement, and show management employs attorneys to enforce any part of the agreement, exhibitor shall reimburse GCF&R for attorney's fees incurred whether or not suit is actually filed.
- g) Exhibitor agrees to obtain, at its own expense, any license(s) and/or permit() and or authorization from government bodies which may be required for the operations of exhibitor's trade of business and to pay all taxes that may be levied against exhibitor as a result of the operation and business during the show.
- h) GCF&R reserves the right, in its sole discretion to: (1) determine the eligibility of exhibitors and exhibits for the show, (2) reject or prohibit exhibits or exhibitors which GCF&R considers objectionable, (3) relocate exhibits when such moves are necessary to maintain the character and/or good order of the show, (4) should any space remain unoccupied on the opening day or at any time thereafter without permission, GCF&R may rent said space to another exhibitor and no show refunds will be given.
- i) All exhibitors parking campers (travel trailers) outside of exhibit space must park in the designated camper parking area only.
- j) Firearms and concealed handguns are prohibited on the Galveston County Fairgrounds.
- k) This is an outdoor event. Exhibitor must have a responsible agent on space to direct any tent set up. No tent will be allowed to set up otherwise.
- l) Excessive use or abuse of alcohol will be grounds for dismissal as determined by GCF&R or its security.

Display and product

- a) Exhibitor agrees to occupy the contracted space during the term of the show and to exhibit only the products described within the application and approved by GCF&R.
- b) GCF&R does not guarantee in any way the attendance figures for any event or the success of any exhibitor.
- c) GCF&R reserves the right to offer exclusivity for any product or offer.
- d) Exhibitors are to have their booth set up between the hours of 10 am and 7:00 pm Friday, June 25th and removed after 5:00 pm on Sunday, June 27th. Exhibitors will be given two vehicle passes for each spot. All vehicle passes must be displayed on dashboard, No vehicles will be permitted to enter or leave between 7:00 pm Friday and 5:00 pm on Sunday.
- e) All exhibitors will be required to enter through the Highway 6 gate.
- f) Exhibitor's working must wear armbands at all times. Exhibitor shall maintain a responsible individual in booth at all times during exhibit hours. Armbands are not transferable and any transfer shall result in expulsion for the Galveston County Fairgrounds.
- g) Exhibit times are 10:00 am to 6:00 pm Saturday, and 10 am to 4:00 pm Sunday.

Assignment and Subletting

- a) The exhibitor shall not assign any rights under these terms and conditions or sublet the space without the prior written permission of the GCF&R.

Indemnity

- a) Exhibitor accepts all risks associated with the use of or occupancy of the exhibit space and shall not make any claim or demand or take any legal action whatsoever against GCF&R show sponsors, attendees or facility for any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to the exhibitor, their officers, employees, agents or their property.
- b) All exhibitors and their working personnel must sign and submit the Participant Indemnity Form prior to the event. Exhibitor assumes all liability for their agents, working personnel and invited guests for any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused.
- c) GCF&R is not responsible for any errors, omissions, typos, misspellings, etc. in any publication, flyer, advertising or electronic media.
- d) Exhibitor is responsibility for any and all damage to the Galveston county Fairgrounds, its building and its attendees.

Exhibitor's Property

- a) Although security is provided during the event, all exhibitors' property at the show shall be at the sole risk of the exhibitor and GCF&R will not assume any responsibility for loss or damage.
- b) All video and/or pictures of exhibitors by GCF&R staff or their assigns shall remain the property of GCF&R for the purpose of promoting the event.
- c) GCF&R will not accept or receive any shipments or goods for any exhibitor. All property must be brought in and out by Exhibitor.

Cancellation and Termination

- a) In the event the exhibitor's check is returned due to insufficient funds, a \$25 fee will be charged and a new application must be filled out and returned with CASH PAYMENT ONLY!
- b) GCF&R reserves the right to cancel the event before the opening date without any liability to itself. In this event, all monies will be refunded.
- c) There will be NO automatic cancellation in the event of rain.
- d) NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON!

Acceptance of Application

- a) This Application, Terms and Conditions, completed Participant Indemnity Form and any other attachments shall be reviewed by GCF&R and notification of acceptance will be conveyed in writing and/or telephone to applicant within approximately two weeks after submission of application.
- b) Upon acceptance of application by GCF&R, payment by check or money order must be made to GCF&R office on the fairgrounds or via mail to the PO Box.
- c) Armbands permit access to any and all events during the Outdoor Show.
