Jackpot Payback: Beginning at 50%

Must have at least 3 horses for Jackpot Classes

Awards Given: Over All High Point and Reserve Over All High Point in each AGE division except PeeWee Division, Halter Champion, Reserve Halter Champion Jackpot, Walk-Trot, and Bareback Eq. Classes WILL count toward Hi-Point Standing. Leadline will NOT count toward the standings.

The PeeWee Division is for Riders from 5-8yrs old!!

The Costume Class is dress you and your horse up in a costume for Easter or anything you'd like to dress up as and the judge will judge you on the rail at a walk.

Attire: Please dress in comfortable attire! Short sleeves are encouraged! Due to the heat, English coats and Western chaps are NOT required.

This is not a "Ride Through The Gate" show. You must pre-enter at least two classes prior to the class you will be entering.

Dogs: All dogs must be leashed!

Gate Rule: The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the arena.

Lead line: Riders may not cross-enter any other class.

Refunds: Refunds of all fees (except office and grounds fees) will be made only in case of illness or injury to a horse or rider and approval of the show staff.

Ribbons: Ribbons will be given through 6th place in each class.

This horse show is conducted in accordance with rules of the American Quarter Horse Assoc.

Indemnity and Responsibility: Submission of an entry to this show constitutes agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold the Horse Show, Galveston County Fair Grounds, show Committee, or any show official harmless against any and all claims, demands, cost and expenses, in thereof, arising from the conduct or management of the Exhibitors business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of exhibitors of any conditions of this agreement, or from any act or negligence of the Exhibitor, its agents, contractors, employees, guest, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against the show and committee or show official or Galveston County Fair and Rodeo by reason of such claim, exhibitor, upon notice from Horse Show, Galveston County Fair Grounds is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft. Property of exhibit left behind is at exit risk.
