Entry Fee: \$35.00 per Team, per Entry – Non-Refundable. You Must be in the BBQ Cook-off to enter Fajitas. There is NO limit on number of entries.

Entry Cut-off Time: Monday, October 9, 2023 at the Fall Fest BBQ Cook-off Chief Cooks Meeting

Judging: 6:45 p.m. Friday, October 13, 2023

Awards: Prize Money to be distributed as follows:

1st Place	30% of the Total Entry Fees
2nd Place	20% of the Total Entry Fees
3rd Place	10% of the Total Entry Fees

Chief Cook's Meeting: Friday, October 13, 2023, 3:30 p.m.

1. One entry form is required for each sample container.
2. Fajita division samples must be beef skirt or flank steak only.
3. Do not include garnish of any kind, foil or plastic/paper containers in the sample container. Only meat is allowed in the container. Fajitas must be cooked on the grounds.
4. Fajita Division samples will be requested at 6:30 p.m. and shall be delivered to the designated Cook-off area by 6:45 p.m.
5. Judging will be in two (2) phases depending on the number of entries. All teams may be required to supply someone to serve as a judge.
 - a. **Exactly 6 samples must be placed in the container for the preliminary division.**
 - b. **Exactly 10 samples must be placed in the container for the final division.**
 - c. **Any more or less than the required number will be disqualified.**
6. Protests of any team, equipment, or meat (any division) must be turned into the cook-off committee no later than one (1) hour prior to judging of that division with the \$100.00 non-refundable fee.
7. All other rules of the 2023 Galveston County Fair BBQ Cook-off apply.
8. All decisions of the Cook-off Committee and the Judges are final.
